Your iPad is:

- When your iPad is not in use, it must be either in the trolley or on your table at the top of your place & away from pencil pots (never put anything on top of your iPad).
- Be a RESPONSIBLE DIGITAL CITIZEN..remember our E-Safety rules.
- When taking photos/videos, you must have consent from the person you are photographing- these should not be shared with anyone else.
- To use AirDrop you must ask for permission- AirDrop will only be used when collaborating on work and sharing learning ideas.
- Use your iPad only for the purpose given by your teacher.
- If your iPad isn't being used at the right times and with respect, it will be temporarily taken away from you.
- Take care when plugging in headphones as the hole can easily be damaged- we want to be able to watch videos on our iPads & enjoy music too.
- Take responsibility for making sure your iPad is correctly plugged into the charging trolley so it has plenty of battery & energy for the following day.
- Keep positive when trying new things on the iPad...you're learning a new skill & at times it may be challenging. Remember, you are learning to also become more Digitally Literate and develop your Computing and Information Technology Skills.
