11. Walk round Netherfield lagoons and visit the lock.
  12. Go to Colwick Park or Gedling Country Park
  13. Feed the ducks somewhere.
14. Spend 15 minutes looking at the night time sky. Can you identify any constellations or planets?
  15. Walk in Colwick Woods, or any other woods.
  16. Bake a cake.
17. Have your photo taken with five famous Nottingham landmarks – see list for suggestions.
  18. Roly-poly down a grassy hill.
19. Visit the Embankment and walk across the Suspension Bridge
20. Do something to improve your local area, like a litter pick or some gardening.
  21. Skim stones.
22. Paddle in the sea, a fountain or a paddling pool.
  23. Make a bug hotel or a bird feeder.
  24. Make bread or a pizza.
25. Hunt for bugs and observe them under a magnifying glass.
26. Learn to ride a bike. If you can already, go on a ride with a family adult.
  27. Learn to count to 10 in three different foreign languages.
  28. Prepare a meal for your family.
29. Listen to a genre of music you've never tried before – reggae, jazz, classical, whatever...
30. Watch a sport you've never watched before – 'live' or on TV.
