
There is a Tag Rugby tournament for Y5/6 on Tuesday afternoon at Arnold Hill! Players chosen already have the details. *Miss Powell*

Communications 1: Our new website should go 'live' today and can be visited at www.parkdale-school.co.uk. Each year group has a page, as does each subject. There's lots more besides.

Communications 2: We are trying to set up a link between the new website and a newly created Facebook page, so that alerts to new web-posts appear there too. This page will be unmonitored by us. It usually takes a few days for new pages to start to appear in searches, but it should eventually get there as Parkdale Primary School, also @parkdalecarlton. Like or follow and updates to the website will pop up there as they happen.

Communications 3: We'd just like to clear up the process for getting hold of us, particularly now teachers aren't on the playground at the start of the day.

- All members of staff are directly available to email. The class teacher is usually the best starting point. Email list attached.
- You can also leave a phone message and ask that they call you back (they can only do this when not in class, of course!). We aim to do this same day.
- If you have something you think needs urgent attention, call the Office. They will ask you what the call is regarding. They will then try to identify the correct person to deal with the matter. You **do** need to tell them what you are calling about, so they can do this. They are school staff and therefore privy to any information and capable of handling it correctly and confidentially.
 - The Head teacher is generally not the best person to deal with issues relating to individual children, as his role is largely strategic, not operational. Others are often better placed to manage this. If they can't then they will escalate it to the Head.
 - Problems or information that cannot go to the class teacher should come directly to:
 - Mr Pattison (KS2)
 - Mrs Burge (KS1)
 - Louisa Desborough (Early Years)
 - Alex Taylor (Special Needs)
 - Jenny Walker (Attendance and Pastoral)
 - Mr Hillier (if the above have not resolved the matter and you wish to escalate the matter)

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- **All of the above can take a call about Safeguarding and are trained to do so.**

Communications 4: For your protection as well as ours, we are still trying to limit in-person face-to-face meetings inside. We are still operating to certain Covid-19 measures and a Risk Assessment which states that we will limit personal contact where other means of communication are possible.

Communications 5: Complaints If you are unhappy with a situation or how a matter has been dealt with, the first point of contact should be the person involved. Our staff are professional and are prepared to engage in a dialogue. The person concerned is usually the best person to resolve an issue. If, having tried this, the matter is not resolved, then it should be escalated. Let the Office know you have a concern, say who it is about and they will direct you to the correct line manager for that person if you are not sure.
