- Enrich cultural capital
- Empower children as agents of change through the Transform values

Each child will tackle TED through an individually tailored programme designed to suit their specific personal co-curricular interests, skills and development needs. This will be scaffolded by Transform values. The children will be encouraged to reflect on how their learning may unify into a single coherent learning experience for the future.

TED's aim is to inspire children to develop skills, talents and character through a wide range of activities, using their curiosity and creativity to find ways of achieving their potential. Having the confidence and drive to live out the Transform values.

This enrichment opportunity will take Transform children beyond the usual to deliver a range of memorable experiences to surprise and delight. It will link to Transform's curriculum, bringing breadth to educational experience and allowing for a more personalised approach.

The Transform Trust community will celebrate the children's achievement at the end of each stage.

- Every Transform child to participate in each activity (2018-19 induction to TED. Foundation and Year 1, 3 and 5 complete full. Years 2, 4 and 6 select from menu of activities as shown on the overleaf)
- Schools to display as appropriate
- Foundation TED's presented in school
- Year 1+2 TED's presented on completion at the end of Year 2 by a member of the Transform team
- Year 3+4 TED's presented on completion at the end of Year 4 by a Trustee
- Year 5+6 TED's graduation at the University on completion at the end of Year 6
