We will also look at extracts from non-fiction, diaries, journals, poetry & other texts linked to our topic.

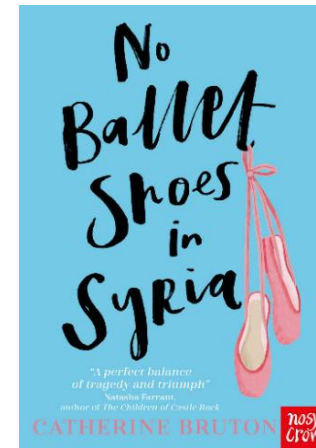
