- Speech and Language specialist support available to all children, including speech sound support, narrative interventions and language programmes.
- All children in Early Years are immersed in Communication Friendly Spaces with trained staff providing Language focused provision.
- Whole school Word Aware programme addresses word deprivation and empowers all children to access the wider curriculum, opportunities and life with appropriate vocabulary.
- EAL children are regularly assessed with the BELL Foundation framework. This assessment stipulates the appropriate support framework.

 Vocabulary acquisition to continue as focus via Word Aware and the Write Stuff.
