Pride

Pride is mostly about gender and identity.

The message of Pride is that it is OK to be what you want to be.

- ▶ To dress how you want to dress.
- ▶ To act how you want to act.
- ▶ To love whoever you want to love.

Your identity

- ► The other main message of Pride is that you can be the kind of person you want to be.
- Wear what clothes you want.
- Enjoy the hobbies and interests you want.
- ► Have your hair how you want it.
- Be with the people you want to be with.



Why is Pride Even Necessary?

- Some people face discrimination because of their identity or who they want to experience love with.
- ► They might be bullied, excluded or not given a fair chance at things.
- ► This sort of behaviour is illegal, but it does happen.



Religion and Thoughts

- Some people believe that it is not OK for men or boys to show characteristics that are traditionally seen as female.
- And the other way around.
- ► This is a view of some religions. That religious view is fine. Remember everyone is entitled to their own religion and thoughts.
- ▶ But... the law in countries which have signed up to the charter of Human Rights is that you cannot discriminate.
- This works to protect everyone. Remember it protects people's thoughts and religions too.



Parkdale/Transform Values

- We act with kindness and understanding
- ► We do not use language that might upset others or make them feel bad about themselves.
- We care about equality; that people have equal opportunities and all are treated in the best way.







- We show mutual respect.
