At Parkdale we are passionate about learning through play, talking and building relationships with our friends, grown-ups, and the world around us. Every minute you spend talking with your child, playing outside or in, or sharing a story will help them learn and grow.

In Reception we hope to help your children, as they begin to read and think about stories, and start their journey to becoming writers. We will help them to build an understanding of numbers and problem solving, through investigation.

English and Maths are a small part of reception.
