Maths

We would like children to spend at least 30 minutes per week on consolidating key mathematical facts. These include:

- Timestable facts up to 12 x 12 (TTRS can help with this)
- Key facts found on the **Year 6 Maths Knowledge Organiser**. In the Spring term, we would like children to focus on measurement conversions, fractions, decimals & percentages, Roman numerals and properties of 2D shapes.

Optional Extras/Menu

- **Maths** - Activities set on MyMaths (please check the back of your child's reading diary for their login details).
- Visit a bird watching location (Netherfield Lagoons or Attenborough Nature Reserve). Take photos of your visit.
- Visit an art gallery (Nottingham Contemporary or Lakeside).
- Go on a woodland walk and find a variety of different leaves. Can you identify which trees these are from? Can you group the leaves according to their characteristics? Think scientifically! Your outcome can be as creative as you like.
- Design and make a meal for your family.
- Go on a 5K walk or join in the Junior Park Run, which is 2K, at Gedling Country Park. You will need a grown up to sign you up for this. Let us know how you do!
