3. Access to lessons across a range of instruments and voice	All children have access to singing assemblies and a range of instruments throughout their time at Parkdale. Extra curricular choir and instrument teaching is offered in addition to the whole class teaching.	To increase the profile and attendance of vocal and instrument extra curricular groups, including brass and drumming lessons.	Music hub to offer extra curricular brass lessons as well as support with in class / whole school singing and music lessons.

6. Provide space for rehearsals and individual practice	Lime Trees used for drumming lessons and brass lessons, the hall for singing assemblies and classrooms for music lessons.	To continue to ensure that space is provided for music lessons to continue.		
7. Develop a termly performance	Nativity/ Christmas whole school, summer performances Year 6. Drumming in spring term – all drummers across school. Termly whole school music celebrations.
