## Summer Term in Nursery

Dear Parents/ Carers,

We are looking forward to beginning a busy and exciting final term of the school year.

Across the Summer Term, our learning will follow two key themes: "What a Wonderful World – Animals and Habitats" and "All Aboard! – Transport and Journeys."

In the first half of the term, we will explore a range of animals and the habitats they live in, including insects, farms, the ocean, the rainforest, the desert and dinosaurs from the past. Through our story of the week and themed provision, the children will learn new vocabulary and develop their imagination, communication and understanding of how we care for the world around us.

In the second half of the term, we will begin our topic "All Aboard!", where we will explore different types of transport including cars, aeroplanes, boats and trains. The children will talk about journeys they have been on and places they would like to visit, learning about how we travel and different destinations.

We will continue our weekly forest school sessions, helping children to develop confidence, physical skills and a love of the outdoors. We will also continue our Squiggle While You Wiggle and Dough Disco sessions to support fine motor development and early writing skills. We will learn a new sign each week and continue to explore all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage through play, adult-led sessions and our key texts.

Towards the end of the term, we will begin thinking about what we want to be when we grow up, supporting the children as they prepare for their transition to Reception. We are looking forward to a range of events this term, including Stay and Play sessions, Sports Day and our Blossombury Festival Day.

Early reading continues to be a key focus. We will share stories every day in Nursery and encourage you to do the same at home by talking about pictures, predicting what might happen next and listening for rhymes and sounds. You can follow your child's learning on Tapestry and we always love seeing your observations from home.

We look forward to a joyful final term together as the children continue to learn, explore and develop.
